Any female high school senior or female college student enrolled in education who has not previously received the scholarship may apply for this \$250 scholarship. The applicant must have graduated from a high school in the Phi Chapter area (Elwood, Holdrege, Alma, Southern Valley, Minden, Axtell, Loomis, Franklin, Wilcox-Hildreth). The scholarship will be granted upon proof of successful completion of one semester of college.

The winner of the scholarship will be announced to the members of Delta Kappa Gamma Phi Chapter at the March meeting. The winner will be invited to the summer meeting (June) to meet the members.

Application materials due include this filled out form, a typed personal statement, and at least two letters of recommendation.*
