## Nebraska Immunization/ Physical Requirements

(5/08)

### **ALL STUDENTS:**

\*3 doses of DTap, DTP or DT vaccine and the 4th dose given on or after the fourth birthday

\*3 doses of Polio vaccine

\*2 doses of MMR vaccine, given on or after 12 months of age and separated by at least 1 month

\*3 doses Hepatitis B vaccine

### **KINDERGARTEN, 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 4<sup>th</sup>, 7<sup>th</sup>, 8<sup>th</sup>, 9<sup>th</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup> & ALL NEW TRANSFER STUDENTS FROM ANOTHER STATE OR COUNTRY:**

\*1 or 2 Varicella immunizations, depending on the age of the student, if there is no history of having had the Chicken Pox disease. (Date that student had the Chicken Pox disease must be on file.). A student over the age of 13 years needs two immunizations, if there is not a history of the disease.

### **KINDERGARTEN, 7<sup>th</sup> GRADE AND ALL NEW TRANSFER STUDENTS FROM ANOTHER STATE OR COUNTRY:**

Beginning with the 2006-07 school year, a vision examination will be required for school entrance. This examination is to be given within 6 months of school entrance and may be given by an optometrist, physician, physician assistant or advanced practice registered nurse. Evaluation must consist of testing for amblyopia, strabismus, internal and external eye health and visual acuity. Documentation of having received the required visual examination must be presented to the school.

\* Physical examination by a Medical doctor, Physician's Assistant or Certified Nurse Practitioner (within 6 months of school entrance)

-There is an immunization clinic the 4th Thursday of the month from 2-4 p.m. at Phelps Memorial Health Center. There is a nominal charge but no one is refused because of inability to pay. Call 1-877-209-3723, toll free for an appointment.
