

InstructionAssessments—Academic Content Standards

The Board of Education adopts the academic content standards of the State Board of Education (“State Board”). The adoption of the academic content standards includes the following:

- Language Arts (reading and writing) standards that were adopted by the State Board on December 11, 2008 and revised by the State Board on April 2, 2009
- Mathematics standards adopted by the State Board on October 8, 2009
- Science standards adopted by the State Board on October 10, 2010

Unless other action is taken, the Board of Education adopts the standards to be adopted by the State Board in the area of Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies and such standards as are subsequently adopted or amended by the State Board.

The administration shall be responsible for implementing assessments on the state standards in accordance with the procedures established by the State Board and the Department of Education, including conducting assessments in the same subject areas and the same grade levels as established in the state standards, and the reporting of scores and sub-scores.

This policy does not supersede the existing standards adopted by the Board of Education (that is, the standards for Social Studies). Those standards are attached to and re-adopted as part of this policy. This policy supersedes the Language Arts, Mathematics, and Science standards previously adopted by the Board of Education.
